Project Details

- Located in the remote tribal village of Hemelkasa, Gadchiroli district, Maharashtra State, India
- Started by social reformer Baba Amte and his son Prakash Amte as a part of bringing the tribes of this remote village to mainstream education, health facilities.
- Established schools for upto 12th board level education, boarding and lodging and medical facilities fully free for the locality.
- Strength about 650 students, 14 aided teachers, 6 non aided teachers/volunteers.

Asha Zurich Contributions

- Provide boarding, lodging and educational expenses for 100 students.
- In terms of money sent – 16,56,000 Rs (about 24,500 CHF)
- LBP was selected in Global Asha's Work an Hour campaign.
- Raised about 4500 chf for LBP projects of 2017
