CAYH & One time donation had a small dip.

Treasurer's report passed by 100% Yes vote.

4.1 Lok Biradari Prakalp by Pratyush

Started funding from 2011 after site visit from Indranil and Kirti in 2010.

Supports 100 students.

2013 site visit by Pratyush.

Children take part in state/national-level athletics, taught art and craft.

4.2 Akshardeep by Akshata

Associated with Asha since 2003.

Supports 300 students.

Most children come from families with income below poverty line, average income Rs 2000 - 3000.

Runs programs from early-childhood to library for adults. Children are given a nutritious meal and medical attention.

Also involved in community development.

Stopped funding from 2014 - the organization is well established and has other sources of funding. Asha Zurich decided to fund other newer projects.

4.3 Palas by Sachin

Supported since 2005.

Site visit done by Anup (Sachin's friend) in 2013.

Most projects are in remote areas, 5 - 10km away from city. Teachers come from same area.

The cost of running is very low because of lack of infrastructure.

Model is to start a school in a para, build it so that its sustainable or taken by govt and them move on to other para.

4.4 SACSAS by Sujit

Since 2010 Asha Zurich is supporting 50% of the school. Romita Dutta visited in 2012.

Schools are taken care by Villagers.
