Asha Zurich is a chapter of Asha for Education, a world- wide organisation that works dedicatedly to catalyze socio-economic change through education of underprivileged children in India. We have no paid staff, no office rent and hence run on very low overheads, typically covered through contributions from volunteers. This is a key factor that distinguishes us from many other organizations. In 2014 Asha Zurich is sending more than 1,000 underprivileged children to school with an annual budget of more than CHF 35,000.

TEAM ASHA IN ZURICH MARATHON

On 6 April, 31 runners ran in the Zurich Marathon, Team Run and City Run to raise awareness and funds for Asha Zurich's projects on education of underprivileged children in India. This year, the fundraising target was set at CHF 20,000. Friends and colleagues of the runners as well as many well-wishers of Asha sponsored the runs by donating to Asha. FUNDRAISERS IN FIRST QUARTER, 2014

INDIAN COOKING COURSE AT MALABAR RESTAURANT TO THE TOTAL PROPERTY OF THE TOTAL PROPERT

On 2 February, the newly-opened, fine-dining Indian restaurant Malabar organized an Indian cooking course. Asha volunteers helped to publicize the course and promoted Asha's ideology to the participants.

Asha received a generous donation of about CHF 800 from Malabar from the profit and would like to thank the owners of the restaurant, Madhu Padmanabhan and Andrea Ries for the collaboration and our prominent volunteer, Doris Hofer for initiating it.

CHAT WITH CHAAT FOOD STAND AT GZ OERLIKON

On 8 March, Asha Zurich jointly organized a food stand with Chat with Chaat, an Indian street-food brand started by Asha Zurich's long-time volunteer Kirtimalini Gadre. Volunteers helped in cooking and serving the food, as well as in promoting Asha. The event was attended by more than a hundred people and helped us raise about CHF 2,000 for our projects. Wonderful team work!

OUR EDUCATIONAL PROJECTS

1. LOK BIRADARI PRAKALP

The project was started by Dr. Prakash and his wife Mandakini Amte. Through this, Asha Zurich supports 100 tribal children in Hemalkasa village, Maharashtra.

The funds sent are used to provide

- Uniforms, books and other stationary items for the students.
- Sports equipment.
- Healthy food three times a day.
- Accommodation in a student dormitory.

Project Status:

• Asha Zurich has approved a budget of about CHF 15,700 for 2014.

2. SAVE CHILDREN SAVE SOCIETY

Asha Zurich became a part of this project in 2010 to fund 50% of the recurring costs comprising of:

- Salary of the teachers
- Uniforms and scholarships for students,
- Text books and other study tools
- School maintenance and scholarships of 164 children in Manipur.

Project Status:

Asha Zurich has approved a budget of about CHF 5,700 for 2014.

3. VISHWAMANDAL SEVASHRAM (VMS - PALAS SCHOOLS)

This project (Palas schools) supports the education of the children of the Bhil tribe in Dulhe district (Maharashtra). Asha Zürich has been associated with the VMS project since 2005 and supports about 981 tribal children.

The funds sent, are spent in providing:

- Salaries of teachers, supervisors and on-site coordinators.
- Educational material for the students.

Project Status:

Asha Zürich has approved a budget of about CHF 15,000 for 2014.

What motivates someone to join Asha?


Let us hear it in the words of Rajdeep Deb, the latest volunteer to join our "Asha Family", as we like to call it.
